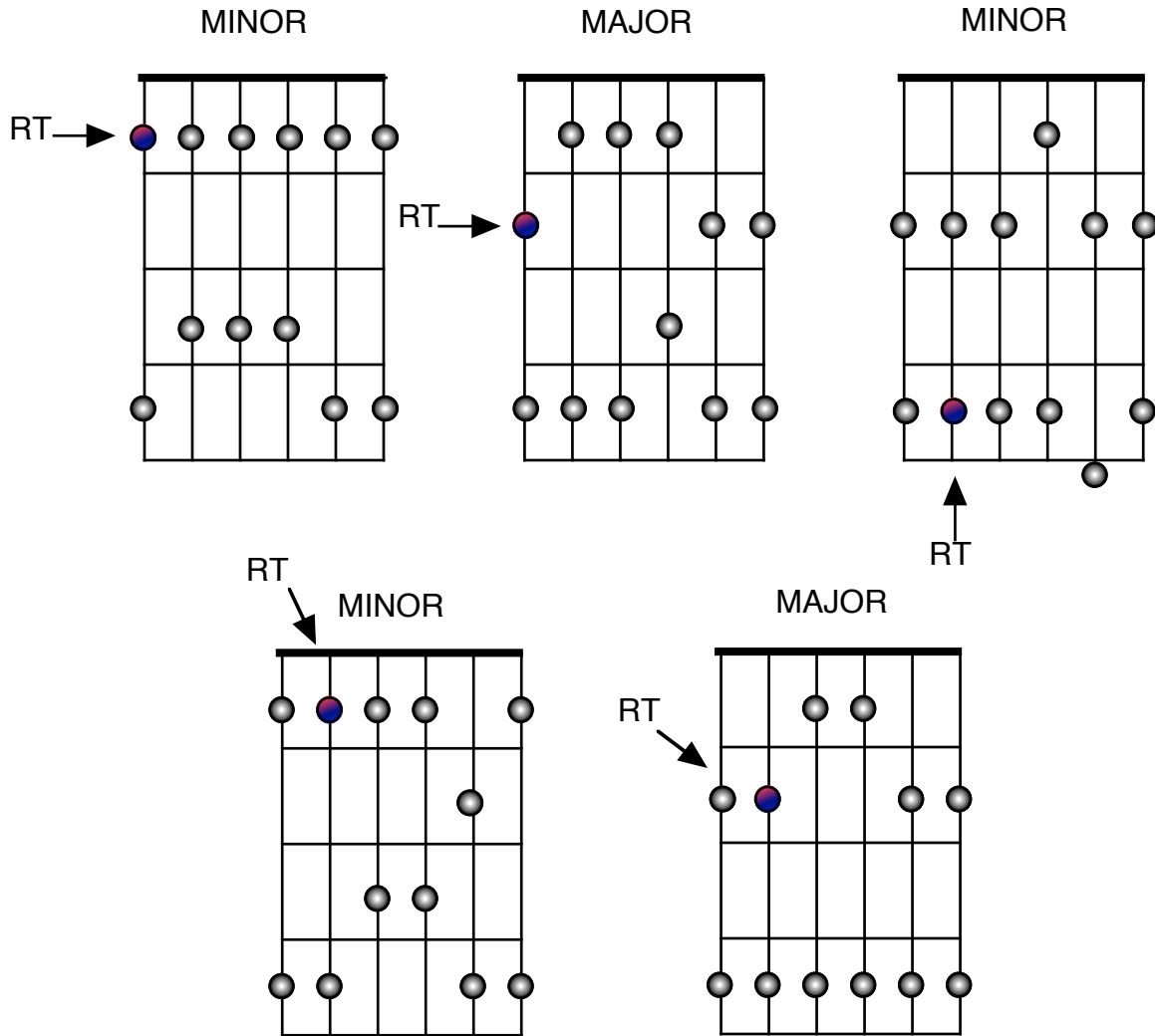


# PENTATONIC SCALE FORMS



A PENTATONIC SCALE IS BASED UPON A SERIES OF “PERFECT” FIFTHS:

C,G,D,A,E = C MAJOR PENTATONIC / A MINOR.

The Major pentatonic contains the following scale degrees;

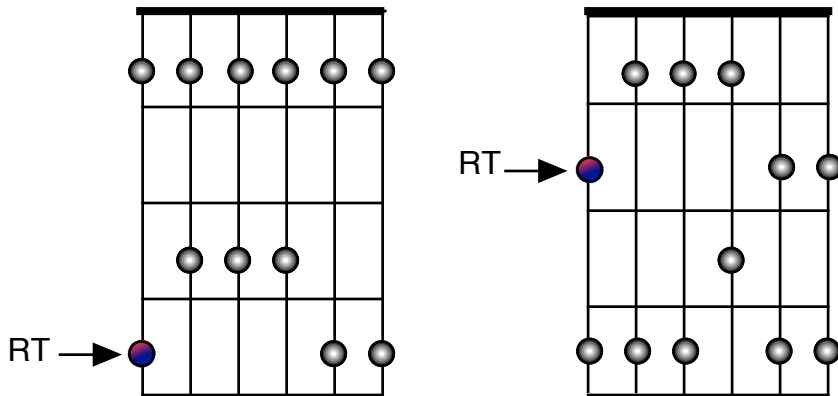
Rt, 2nd, 3rd, 5th and 6th

The minor pentatonic contains; Rt, b3, 4, 5, and b7

# Level Four Major and Minor Pentatonic Scales

The Major Pentatonic Scale consists of the following scale degrees;

Rt, 2nd, 3rd, 5th, 6th



The “Melodic Minor” or Kumoi Pentatonic Scale consists of the following scale degrees;

Rt, 2nd, b3rd, 5th, 6th

It is essentially a Melodic Minor scale minus the 4th and 7th.
